History of HE in the Czech Republic

- First university: Charles
 University, Prague in 1348
- Palacký University, Olomouc, 1573
- 1918, establishment of Czechoslovak state, enhancement of HE and founding of more universities
- Three cycle structure since 2001



Degree structure and academic year

- Three cycle structure: bachelor`s, master`s, doctoral degree programs
- Bachelor`s: 3-4 years
- Master`s: 1-3 years, or full master`s: 4-6 years
- Doctoral: usually 3 years
- MBA programs are also offered
- Academic year: 12 months, 2 semesters, starting in October and March; exam period lasts 5 weeks after each semester

Admission requirements and tuition fees for degree studies

- Public and state institutions are free of charge for citizens of all nationalities, with the following exceptions: administration of admission proceedings; extending the duration of study beyond a set limit; the study of an additional program to the original studied; study in a foreign language.
- **Private institutions** can fix their own fees, the tuition fees differ from 2,000-15,000 EUR per year.
- Language: set by institution, usually proven B2 level of CZ or EN
- Matriculation exam (bachelor`s) or relevant degree (master`s, PhD)


Czecz University of Life Sciences, Prague

- Emphasis on research and international collaboration in research
- Famous for participating in CERN and its Egyptology research

- Department of Economics,

- English B2
- Study cycle: 1,2; 3 only in the field of Business Administration



- Named after Mendel the father of genetics, the university has 5 more faculties besides Agronomy today
- Participation in interdisciplinary research

Palacký University, Olomouc

- 2nd oldest university established in 1573
- Today the university aims to enhance European collaboration in research
- A real university city: highest ratio of student/population in CZ
- 14 full English programs bachelor's and master's programs and doctoral programs in 6 fields
- Host of Academia Film Olomouc film festival for 50 years

- Study cycle: 1, 2, 3 only in the field of German
- Founded with the aim to set balance between humanities and technical studies of an industrial region in 1991
- European Research Institute for Social Work and Institute for Research and Application of Fuzzy Modelling

College of European and Regional Studies, České Budějovice

- The first private college of the Region of South Bohemia
- Aims to educate public administration professionals on a European level
- Editorial office of the journal Auspicia
